



Teague I.S.D. Board of Trustees Meeting Summary

The Board of Trustees of the Teague Independent School District met in Regular Session in the TISD Central Administration Office on March 22, 2007 beginning at 5:16 p.m.

Board Members present were: Scott Hamilton (Vice President), Randy Bruce (Member), J.D. Hancock (Member), Richard Steen (Member) and Stan Waldrip (Member). Members absent: Jeff Gonzales and Lovie Whyte. Administrative staff members present were: Ned Burns, Jerry Burger, Mary Clary, Darrell Evans, Donnie Osborn, Vickey Little, Carol Ann Dawley and Fred Tucker.

The meeting was called to order and a quorum was established.

Mrs. Cari Martin, THS Band Director, presented the Sweepstakes Trophy recently earned by the THS Band. This is the first time that the THS Band has earned the prestigious honor. Mrs. Martin presented the Trustees with information regarding the Band trip to Florida in the summer of 2008.

Mr. Donnie Osborn, Director of Transportation, informed the Trustees that the recently purchased school bus has been delivered and placed into regular service.

The minutes for the meeting held on February 22, 2007 were approved as presented.

Current bills in the amount of \$2,306,511.63 were approved for payment. (Bills included a \$2,028,613 'Robin Hood' payment)

The following reports were presented: Tax Collector's Report; February 2007 Financial Report; Enrollment Report; and Instructional Report.

Mr. Darrell Evans (THS Principal) noted that the THS One Act Play recently advanced from zone competition to district final competition to be held at Groesbeck. Kyle Dillon, Blake Ryan, Paul Ferguson, Hilton George, Caitlin Chatham, Rachel Bowers and Michael Harvey were named to the All Star Cast

The Trustees were informed of the recent meeting of the Future Facility Needs Committee held on March 7, 2007. The next meeting of the committee will be held on April 7, 2007.

Mrs. Carol Ann Dawley updated the Trustees regarding the construction progress at the Elementary School. The concrete foundations are scheduled to be poured within the next few days.

The proposed TISD Hourly Wage Schedule was presented by Mary Clary, Business Manager. The proposed wage schedule increases the minimum wage paid to auxiliary staff to \$7.25 per hour for next school year. The proposal will be considered as part of the 2007-08 budget process.

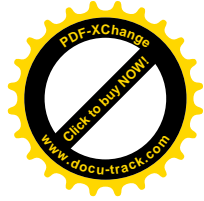
