

**Teague I.S.D. Board of Trustees
Meeting Summary**

The Board of Trustees of the Teague Independent School District met in Regular Session in the TISD Central Administration Office on April 26, 2007 beginning at 5:17 p.m.

Board Members present were: Jeff Gonzales (President), Scott Hamilton (Vice President), Randy Bruce (Member), J.D. Hancock (Member), and Lovie Whyte (Secretary). Members absent: Richard Steen and Stan Waldrip. Administrative staff members present were: Ned Burns, Jerry Burger, Mary Clary, Darrell Evans, Vickey Little, Carol Ann Dawley and Fred Tucker.

The meeting was called to order and a quorum was established.

Mrs. Mary Margaret Pate, THS UIL Academic Coordinator, reported to the Trustees that the Teague High School students won first place in the District 22-AA academic competition for 2006-07. Mrs. Pate presented several of the academic winners.

The meeting minutes held on March 22, 2007 were approved as presented.

The Trustees authorized payment of current bills in the amount of \$2,335,852.49 (includes a required \$2,028,613 "Robin Hood" payment).

Internal budget transfers and adjustments with no increase to the total budget were approved as presented.

The following reports were presented to the Trustees:

- ❖ Tax Collector's Report – indicating a 97.11% collection rate thus far;
- ❖ Current Financial Report – revenue collection of \$25,554,942; expenditures of \$11,769,926;
- ❖ Enrollment Report – 1,184 students currently enrolled; and
- ❖ Instructional Report – display of THS student art in the central office lobby, Senior scholarship award night scheduled for May 10th, and report regarding summer staff development plans.

The following topics were discussed by the Trustees:

- *Future Facility Needs Committee Meetings Update – the committee report is being developed for presentation to the Trustees during their May meeting.
- *The Elementary School Additional Classrooms/Restrooms Update – construction is on schedule for completion in late July or early August; approximately 35% of the project is completed.
- *The proposed changes to the TISD Random Drug Testing Policy were discussed. A copy of the proposed changes can be reviewed on website: www.teagueisd.org -- Administration. These proposed changes will be considered for adoption during the May meeting.
- *The proposed 2007-08 Paraprofessional Salary Scales were discussed. These proposed salary scales will be presented for adoption during the May meeting.

The proposed 2007-08 Hourly Wage scale was approved as previously presented.

Two additional Ram-Tech temporary buildings (each building housing 2 classrooms) (1 building for High School and 1 building for Intermediate School) were approved to be purchased from the TASB Buy-Board. Total cost for purchase, delivery and set-up is approximately \$80,000 each.

Teague ISD paraprofessional contracts for the 2007-08 school year were approved as presented.
