

Teague I.S.D. Board of Trustees Meeting Summary

The Board of Trustees of the Teague Independent School District met in Regular Session in the TISD Central Administration Office on April 24, 2008 beginning at 5:16 p.m.

Board Members present were: Jeff Gonzales (President), Scott Hamilton (Vice President), Lovie Whyte (Secretary), J.D. Hancock (Member), Debra Lawrence (Member) and Stan Waldrip (Member). Members absent: Randy Bruce. Administrative staff members present were: Ned Burns, Jerry Burger, Mary Clary-Smith, Darrell Evans, Donnie Osborn, Vickey Little and Carol Ann Dawley.

The meeting was called to order and a quorum was established.

Mrs. Mary Margaret Pate (THS UIL Coordinator) presented Regional UIL Academic finalists students Matt Flori (Current Events) coached by Caroline Conley (Librarian), Danny Thach (Spelling/vocabulary) coached by Carrie Scales (THS Teacher) and Cooper Brown (Persuasive Speaking) coached by Mary Sue Smith (THS Teacher).

Mr. Darrell Evans presented Coach Marvin Childs, Coach Taylor Sims, Coach Shaun Moore and the 2008 Boys Basketball Team. Recently Coach Childs had been selected as the Cen-Tex Basketball Coach of the Year.

The minutes for the meeting held on March 27, 2008 were approved as presented.

Current bills in the amount of \$1,561,648.20 were approved as presented

Mrs. Rene' Huffman was appointed as election judge for the Donie precinct.

The Superintendent presented and gave a brief review of the architectural plans being developed for the new Secondary School Complex. The current time line indicates that the complex will be completed during the summer of 2010. Mrs. Little, Intermediate School Principal, gave brief review regarding the expansion plans for the Intermediate School.

Mr. Darrell Evans (THS Principal) explained the reasons for the increase subsidy request for the Secondary School yearbook.

The Trustees reviewed the requested changes to the THS Local Sick Leave Policy. The proposed changes will be considered for adoption (effective for the 2008-09 school year).

Local Sick leave--Professional Personnel

Professional employees who have exhausted state leave may receive thirty (30) equivalent workdays of extended sick leave. When the local sick leave is used for the employee's personal illness/disability, including pregnancy-related disability, or there is an illness in the immediate family or death in the immediate family and the need of such sick leave is verified by a doctor's certification, the rate of pay for a certified substitute (\$65.00) shall be deducted from the employee's pay for each day of local sick leave taken whether or not a substitute is employed. If the days absent are for any other reason than listed above or the employee has exhausted all state and local sick leave then they shall be docked their full daily rate of pay.

Local Sick Leave – Paraprofessional Employee

Paraprofessional employees who have exhausted state leave may receive thirty (30) equivalent workdays of extended sick leave. When the local sick leave is used for the employee's personal illness/disability, including pregnancy-related disability, or there is an illness in the immediate family or death in the immediate family and the need of such sick leave is verified by a doctor's certification, the paraprofessional employee will be docked at a rate of 50% of their daily rate (not to exceed \$40 per day) from the employee's pay for each day of local sick leave taken whether or not a substitute is employed.
