#### **PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF NONDISCRIMINATION IN:**

- 1) The Teague ISD offers career and technology education programs in Vocational Agricultural, Vocational Home Economics, and Business Education. Admission to these programs is based on grade placement and student request.
