## **Directions to Teague High School**

From North I-45 & South I-45(Fairfield)-If you are coming from North or South I-45 into Fairfield, take Exit 197, Highway 84, which is to Teague. The high school is on Highway 84.

Travel east on Highway 84 from Mexia into Teague; Teague is 10 miles from Mexia.

Once you arrive at the high school, drive to the back of the school where you'll see the cafeteria. Park in the back parking lot and enter through the cafeteria. The registration table will be located in the long hallway just through the cafeteria doors. Students will congregate in the cafeteria all day.
