

Teague I.S.D. Board of Trustees Meeting Summary

The Board of Trustees of the Teague Independent School District met in Regular Session in the TISD Central Administration Office on April 28, 2011 beginning at 5:20 p.m.

Board Members present were: Jeff Gonzales (President), Debra Lawrence (Vice President), Trustee Brian Bowers (Member), Randy Bruce (Member), Stan Waldrip (Member) and Sushma Walker (Member). Members absent- Lovie Whyte. Administrative staff members present were: Ned Burns, Bryan Clemmons, Mary Clary-Smith, Carol Ann Dawley, Donnie Osborn and Drake Paris.

The meeting was called to order and a quorum was established.

The meeting minutes for March 24, 2011 were approved as presented; and the corrected minutes for January 27, 2011 were approved as presented.

Current bills in the amount of \$3,533,067.55 were approved as presented.

Budget amendments (internal transfers only) were approved as presented.

As recommended by the Administration, the Prosperity Bank (Teague) was approved to be the school district's depository bank for the 2011-2013 years.
